Current Internship Opportunities

Paid Internship (Application deadline 3/4/2016)

Time-line & Details:

- Part time position 3 days a week
- \$75 daily stipend (per full 8-hour day)
- Summer extensions may be possible based on performance, program needs, and funding
- Positions located in San Diego, CA

Duties:

- Provide assistance to Education Coordinator
- Be trained in and lead educational programs to K-12 groups
- Receive and process requests for education programs, fee waivers and tidepool permits
- When needed and available, assist with basic park operations such as visitor center desk shifts, special events, closing procedures, etc

Intern Benefits:

- \$75 daily stipend (per full day)

- Assist visitors with orientation, information and interpretive needs
- Present informal and/or basic formal interpretive or informational programs
- Assist with basic park operations such as special events, closing procedures, etc
